All Positions Will Require the candidate to submit a 1-2 page typed, double-spaced, 12-point standard font, 1 inch margins, essay covering the following questions:

1. What skills/traits/characteristics makes someone an effective leader?
2. What qualities would you bring to the leadership position you are seeking?
3. What is your vision for the Lancer Band and Color Guard and how would you help enact it. Please cite specific examples of ways you'd like to improve the organization.

*Drum Major candidates be specific about the DM position when discussing the above questions.*

**Interviews will be held for Drum Major, Captains, and Managers. Interviews may be held for section leaders, crew and librarian.**

**For the Interview please be prepared to discuss:**

- Your specific leadership experience
- Your understanding of the band program with regards to the LMB and Honor Band
- Your experience in conflict resolution
- Ideas for improving band program (rehearsals, leadership, organization, etc...)
